Prayer is for grant of regular bail on behalf of the petitioner-husband in case FIR No.192 dated 3.09.2014 for offences punishable under Sections 306 and 34 of Indian Penal Code registered with Police Station Morinda, District Rupnagar being tried for the death of his wife Karamjit Begum due to the drowning in the Canal.

The petitioner is the sole accused and it is stated by the State Counsel assisted by HC Surinder Singh that only two witnesses i.e. the Doctor conducting the post mortem and another formal witness remains to be examined. They have been summoned for 23.12.2015.

Faced with the aforesaid situation, learned Counsel for the petitioner prays for permission to withdraw the present petition.

Dismissed as withdrawn.

It is hoped that the trial Court would expedite the conclusion of the trial.
