ANITA CHAUDHRY, J.

The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No. 71 dated 13.08.2015, registered under Sections 395, 333, 353, 186 IPC, Police Station Mullanpur Garibdass, District SAS Nagar.

Heard.

Counsel for the petitioner contends that all the other accused who were wanted in this case had been released on bail and the petitioner is in custody since 09.10.2015.

The State counsel informs that there were three persons who were on a motorcycle and four persons had come on

a car and the petitioner was travelling in the car and two accused with similar allegations had been allowed bail under Section 167(2) Cr.P.C. while Jitender had been given the concession of bail on account of his physical disability. He also states that the challan is ready and would be filed.

Investigation is almost over, challan will be submitted shortly. There is no other case against the petitioner. The trial will take long time to conclude. Without commenting upon the merits of the case, the petition is allowed and the petitioner is directed to be released on regular bail on execution of adequate personal and surety bonds to the satisfaction of trial Court.
