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MAHESH GROVER, J.

The petitioner prays for her release on bail in terms of Section 438 Cr.P.C. in a case registered vide FIR No.249 dated 23.11.2013 under Sections 420/467/468/120-B IPC at Police Station City Khanna, District Ludhiana.

It is contended by the learned counsel for the petitioner that the FIR has been registered by the disgruntled husband on account of marital discord between the petitioner and him. The marriage is fairly old i.e. more than two decades.

This Court on 11.12.2014 had granted the interim protection to the petitioner, pursuant to which she has joined the

investigation to the satisfaction of the Investigating Officer which fact is not disputed by the learned counsel for the State of Punjab on instructions from SI Davinder Singh.

Having regard to the aforesaid, the interim directions dated 11.12.2014 are hereby made absolute subject to the condition that the petitioner continues to comply with the provisions of Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition allowed.
