Prayer made in the present petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No. 90 dated 08.05.2015 under Sections 307, 323, 447, 511, 506, 148, 149 IPC and Sections 27 of the Arms Act, 1959, registered at Police Station Machhiwara, District-Ludhiana.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is 70 years old man and has received seven injuries, out of which four are grievous in nature. A cross-version has been recorded at the instance of the petitioner.

On the other hand, learned counsel for the complainant has argued that Bhag Singh was attacked by Puran Singh (present petitioner). Gun shot injuries were inflicted on the right arm of Bhag

Singh. Injured-Bhag Singh remained in hospital for more than one month and because of these injuries, he is not able to perform his day to day work. He further submits that in the cross-case, the injury inviting offence under Section 307 has already been deleted.

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI-Harpal Singh, submits that though the petitioner has joined investigation but no recovery has been effected from him and the injuries attributed by the petitioner, are grievous in nature and are dangerous to life.

Heard.

Taking into consideration the fact that the allegation against the petitioner is serious in nature, coupled with the fact that petitioner and other co-accused have committed serious offence and the injuries inflicted are the gun shot injuries fired at injured-Bhag Singh, no ground for anticipatory bail is made out.

Dismissed.
