DAYA CHAUDHARY, J. (ORAL)

The present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C for issuance of direction to respondents No.2 to 5 to register an FIR against respondents No.6 to 20.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that a civil suit filed by the petitioner for permanent injunction is pending before the competent court of Additional Civil Judge (Senior Division), Zira. An interim injunction has also been passed on 30.09.2014. Learned counsel further submits that the private respondents have admitted to take forcible possession of the land, in dispute and the petitioner was taken forcibly to the police Station. He further submits that the complaint was made to the concerned Station House Officer and thereafter, a representation was also made to Senior Superintendent of Police but no action has been taken thereupon so far.

Learned counsel for the petitioner also submits that the petitioner would be satisfied, in case, the representation filed by him be disposed of in accordance with law as no order has been passed.

Without commenting anything on the merits of the case and keeping in view the limited prayer of the petitioner, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to look into the representation (Annexure P-5) and take necessary action in accordance with law within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

The petition is, disposed of accordingly.
