The petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail in case bearing FIR No.63 dated 02.08.2014, under Sections 420, 467, 468, 471 IPC, P.S. Bhaini Mian Khan, District Gurdaspur.

On 16.12.2014, this Court passed the following order:-

“Petitioner seeks the concession of pre-arrest bail in a case registered at the instance of Balwinder Kaur alleging that the petitioner alongwith others had promised to recruit the son of the complainant in Railways and a sum of Rs.40000/- have been obtained.

Counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is a girl who is a student of MCA and that even otherwise, the matter has been compromised inter-se the

complainant and Nirmal Singh as per affidavit annexure P-2.

Notice of motion to Advocate General, Punjab for March 17, 2015.

Meanwhile, an interim direction is issued that the petitioner will join investigation on December 27, 2014, and in case of her doing so, she will be released on interim bail to the satisfaction of the arresting officer.”

Thereafter, on 17.03.2015, learned State Counsel submitted that though the petitioner has joined investigation but he has not co-operated with the Investigating Agency.

On 05.05.2015, this Court sought verification from the State counsel with regard to status of investigation.

Today learned State counsel has filed status report by way of affidavit and on instructions from ASI Narinder Singh states that in pursuance to order dated 17.03.2015 passed by this Court, petitioner has joined the investigation and has also co-operated.

In view of the above, interim order dated 16.12.2014 is made absolute.

Petitions stands disposed of.
