This is a petition under 482 Cr.P.C. for a direction to respondent No.2 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner at the hands of respondents No.3 to 5 and to look into the representation filed by the petitioner Anneujxre P-1.

On notice having been issued, the affidavit has been filed by Additional Deputy Commissioner of Police (Crime), Jalandhar on behalf of official respondents to the effect that respondent No.5 had filed a complaint on 06.09.2014 alleging that Deepak Bali has introduced his son Rajan Verma who was desirous of going abroad with the petitioner and thereafter the petitioner had taken his son Rajan Verma and his companion to Bangkok

introducing himself as travel agent. The petitioner had allegedly promised to arrange work permit visa of Canada from Bangkok.

Without going into the details and result of the investigation, it is sufficient to observe that petitioner along with complainant-respondent No.5 were found to be prima facie guilty of duping Jaspal Singh for a sum of Rs.12,00,000/-. The enquiry in this aspect is stated to be still pending.

In view of the matter being taken in accordance with law by the concerned quarters, no direction is required to be issued in the present case.

This petition is dismissed.
