In pursuance of the earlier orders, affidavit has been filed by Shri Kulwinder Singh, Assistant Director (S.A.2) office of Director of Public Instructions (Secondary Education) Punjab, who is present in person. As per the contents of the affidavit, the petitioners have been given the notional promotion in the Master Cadre from 29.10.2001, from which date the juniors were promoted (Annexure R1). The relevant paragraph reads as under:

“3. That in this regard, it is respectfully submitted that the original record pertaining to the promotions made vide order dated 29-10-2001 is not traceable in the department. Therefore petitioners were given opportunity to personal hearing in this regard on dated 7-08-2015 at 11.00 AM by the answering deponent for redressal of their grievances. After considering the facts submitted by the petitioners during the personal hearing and going through the record on file speaking order No. 20/145-2002 Estt. 2(4) dated 18-08-2015 have been passed and the petitioners are promoted to Master Cadre as DPE on notional basis w.e.f. 29-10-2001. (Copy of the speaking order is annexed as Annexure R-I)”

Thus, it is apparent that the necessary relief has been granted to the petitioners.

Accordingly, the present writ petition is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.
