Sandeep Kumar son of Sansar Chand has applied for grant of regular bail in FIR No. 32 dated 13.07.2014 under Section 306 of the Indian Penal Code registered at Police Station Talwara, Hoshiarpur.

Earlier the case was fixed for 20.01.2015 but the petitioner moved an application vide CRM No. 61 of 2015 alleging that he is an army personnel and if he remains in custody for six months, he can be dismissed from service. So, prayer was made for preponing the main case. Notice of that application was given to Advocate General, Punjab, for today. Accordingly, the main case stands preponed for today.

As per allegations of the prosecution, deceased Bandana Kumari was married to the petitioner in the year 2002. She was subjected to cruelty at the hands of petitioner and his family members. ₹1,00,000/- was demanded which was paid on 28.04.2010. Later on another demand of ₹50,000/- was made for raising construction. In view of constant demands made by the petitioner and his family members, Bandana Kumari committed suicide.

The petitioner is the husband of deceased. There is specific allegation of demand made by the petitioner in the dying declaration. The parents of the petitioner have been allowed the concession of bail on the ground that their names do not figure in the dying declaration.

In these circumstances, no ground for grant of regular bail is made out.

Dismissed.
