Counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has surrendered before the summoning Court in pursuance of directions issued by this Court and has been released on bail. He is ready to face proceedings in accordance with law.

Counsel for the complainant has submitted that as sister of the complainant lost her life during her stay in the matrimonial home, the petitioner does not deserve concession of pre-arrest of bail.

I have heard counsel for the parties and in view of the facts noted in the order dated 22.12.2014, I am of the considered opinion that interim bail granted to the petitioner deserves to be made absolute and ordered accordingly. However, the petitioner shall remain bound by the conditions envisaged under Section 428(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
