DAYA CHAUDHARY, J. (ORAL)

This petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.PC for issuance of directions to respondents No.2 and 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner and her family members at the hands of respondent No.4.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that many complaints (Annexures P-1 to P-4) and representations have been made by the petitioner to the higher authorities but no action has been taken thereupon so far.

Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that the petitioner would be satisfied, in case, the directions are issued to respondent No.2 to consider the complainants (Annexures P-1 to P-4) moved by her within some stipulated period.

Without commenting anything on the merits of the case and

keeping in view the submissions made by learned counsel for the petitioner that the complaints moved by the petitioner are pending and still no action has been taken thereupon, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to take action on the complaints, which are annexed as Annexures P-1 to P-4, in accordance with law within a period of two weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

The petition is disposed of accordingly.
