**M.M.S. BEDI, J (ORAL)**

Petitioners seeks concession of regular bail in a case registered at the instance of Jitender Kumar alleging that the complainant was threatened by non-applicant Tarsem Singh and other associates demanding a sum of Rs.20 lac and giving threats to kidnap nephew of the complainant. A complaint was lodged with the police. On account of said circumstances, complainant and his brother were fired at by non-applicant Ram Pal and Rahul. The shot fired hit PW-4 Rinku. So far as petitioners are concerned they are not named in the FIR but they are alleged to have made disclosure statements to the effect that main accused Tarsem had deputed them to stand near the place of occurrence on the date of firing.

It is sufficient to observe here that injured Rinku has turned hostile. Co-accused of the petitioners namely Rakesh Kumar and Ajmer have been granted the concession of bail.

Taking into consideration the fact that the petitioners have been in custody w.e.f.11.03.2014, no specific injury having been attributed to them, they can be granted the concession of bail.

It has been informed that the petitioners were involved in another case pertaining to the same occurrence and they have been granted bail in the said case.

Without expression of any opinion on merits, the petition is allowed. Petitioners are ordered to be released on bail on their furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.
