Prayer in this application is for disposal of the writ petition by taking the same on board in the light of the judgment dated 20.11.2014 passed by this Court in the case of the petitioners, where they had prayed for absorption in CID (Intelligence). Counsel thus contends that in case the claim of the petitioners is considered in Civil Writ Petition No.11424 of 2006 and is accepted, the petitioners may be held entitled to the benefit of the consequential benefits, which includes promotion, as has been prayed in the present writ petition.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Ms. Svaneel Jaswal, Deputy Advocate General, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and states that she has no objection to the disposal of the main writ petition.

In view of the above, the main writ petition is taken on board for final disposal as per the consent given by the counsel for the parties and

disposed of by observing that in case the claim of the petitioners for absorption in CID (Intelligence) is accepted, they shall be entitled to the benefit of consideration for promotion from the date their juniors were promoted as per the seniority, which is now to be framed by the respondents on their absorption, if granted.
