Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for issuing direction to the District & Sessions Judge (Vigilance), Chandigarh or any other judicial authority to look into the alleged torture given by respondents No.3 and 4 and their accomplice namely Lakhan Singh son of Rachhpal Singh. Petitioner is stated to have submitted a representation dated 1.12.2015 (Annexure P-2) addressed to the Director General of Police, Punjab, Chandigarh.

A perusal of representation (Annexure P-2) shows that same has been made only recently i.e. on 01.12.2015 and without waiting the outcome of that representation, petitioner has approached this Court. Even otherwise also, petitioner has an alternative remedy available under the law but same has not been availed by him.

In view of the above, no indulgence of this Court is required at this stage. Accordingly, present petition is hereby dismissed.
