AJAY TEWARI, J. (Oral)

Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 482 of the Cr.P.C. is for issuance of a direction to the official respondents to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners and not to harass them at the instance of respondent Nos.5 and 6.

The petitioners have got married against the wishes of their parents. They are stated to be major. In support of his proof of age petitioner No.1 has placed on record photocopy of his passport (Annexure P-1) wherein his date of birth is mentioned as 10.09.1989 and petitioner No.2 has also placed on record photocopy of her passport (Annexure P-2) depicting her date of birth as 23.11.1996. They have also moved a representation jointly addressed to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Patiala and SHO, P.S.Tripuri Town, Patiala (Annexure P-4) for protection of their life and liberty.

Without advertent to the merits of the controversy, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2, Senior Superintendent of Police, Patiala to take appropriate action on the said representation (Annexure P-4).

Since the main case has been decided, the pending Criminal Misc. Application, if any, also stands disposed of.
