This is a petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. seeking regular bail to petitioner in a case registered against him vide FIR No.7 dated 06.01.2012 under Sections 22/61/85 of NDPS Act, 1985 at Police Station Sadar Khanna, Distt. Ludhiana.

Learned State counsel submit that out of 08 witnesses cited by prosecution 02 witnesses have been examined and 01 witness has been given up. He further submits that prosecution shall not delay the case in any manner.

In view of above, learned counsel for petitioner submits that he may be allowed to withdraw this petition with liberty to petitioner to file afresh in case trial does not conclude within a period of six months.

Dismissed as withdrawn with aforesaid liberty.
