SABINA, J.

Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 seeking regular bail in FIR No.413 dated 09.07.2013, under Sections 392, 394, 397, 120-B of Indian Penal Code, 1860 and Sections 25 of Arms Act, 1959, registered at Police Station Bahadurgarh, District Jhajjar.

Heard.

Material witnesses have failed to identify the accused during trial, before the trial Court. There was no recovery of the amount in question from the petitioner. Petitioner is in custody for the last more than one year.

On a query put by this Court, learned State counsel, on instructions from Assistant Sub Inspector Suresh Kumar has submitted that the petitioner is not involved in any other criminal case.

Accordingly, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this petition is allowed. Petitioner be admitted to bail subject to the satisfaction of Chief Judicial Magistrate, Jhajjar.
