Petitioner seeks concession of regular bail in a case of recovery of 1 kg 400 grams of charas from Ashok Kumar who was arrested along with said quantity of charas. The petitioner was involved in the case on the basis of his disclosure statement to the effect that he had bought the contraband from the petitioner. The petitioner is charged of having committed offence under Section 27-A of the NDPS Act.

Whether the petitioner could be said to have in actual physical possession of charas recovered from his co-accused and whether the disclosure statement of co-accused would be admissible or relevant will certainly be a debatable issue during course of trial, he can be granted the concession of bail. The petitioner has been in custody since 16.03.2015.

Petition is allowed. Petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.
