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KULDIP SINGH, J. (ORAL)

Petitioner seeks regular bail under Section 167(2) Cr.P.C. in a case pertaining to FIR No. 94 dated 24.10.2013, registered under Section 18 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985, at Police Station Mehna, District Moga, on the ground that the challan was presented without Forensic Science Laboratory (FSL) report, which amounts to incomplete challan. Therefore, he is entitled to regular bail under Section 167 (2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel has informed the Court that now, the FSL report has also been filed. Once the challan is presented, the right of the accused comes to an end under Section 167 (2) Cr.P.C. Mere fact that one of the report was filed late is no ground to grant regular bail under the said Section.

Hence, dismissed.
