Without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is **disposed of** with a direction to respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Pathankot, to look into the representation dated 10.11.2015 (Annexure P-3) allegedly filed by the petitioner, and decide the same in accordance with law.
