The present petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. has been filed for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.128 dated 09.10.2014 registered under Sections 420, 465, 467, 468, 471, 120B, 379, 188 of IPC and 21(1) of Mining Act at Police Station Sadar Rupnagar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has raised various arguments of false implication in the case where as learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Krishan Lal submits that the investigation has not been completed so far and the petitioner is having remedy under Section 167(2) Cr.P.C. which has not been availed.

At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioner wants to withdraw this petition with liberty to avail appropriate remedy.
