The present petition has been filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.24 dated 20.01.2014, registered under Section 22 of the NDPS Act, at Police Station Jodhewal City, Distt. Ludhiana.

The learned counsel refers to Annexure P-3, the death certificate of her son, Jasvir Singh, dated 24.07.2015, and states that the petitioner being in a sad state of mind, failed to note down the correct date, resulting into absence on 31.10.2015. Further states that the absence from the process of the Court was not wilful and deliberate. He undertakes to be vigilant in future and would not repeat the lapse.

Notice of motion.

At the asking of the Court, Ms. Harsimrat Rai, DAG, Punjab, accepts notice. A complete copy of the paper book has been handed over to the learned State counsel, in the Court.

Without adverting to the merits of the present case and keeping in view the fact that the son of the petitioner died on 24.07.2013, this petition is disposed of with a direction that in case, the petitioner appears before the trial Court within one week from today, she shall be admitted to bail by the trial Court, on furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds, to its satisfaction.
