Jahid Ali s/o Ahsaan Ali has applied for grant of regular bail in FIR No. 85 dated 16.10.2014 under Section 22 of the Narcotic Drugs and Pschotropic Substances Act registered at Police Station Sadar Rajpura, District Patiala.

As per allegations of the prosecution, 80 ampules of bonogesic (a pain killer) and 80 vials of avil (anti-allergic) were recovered from one Inderjit Singh s/o Karnail singh. It is alleged that the said injections have been allegedly purchased from the shop of petitioner. The petitioner has alleged himself as licensed chemist and druggist.

On 19.12.2014, the State was directed to verify the said license. Learned State counsel has submitted that the Drugs

Inspector has verified the said license. The connection between the petitioner and that Inderjit Singh is the disclosure statement of Inderjit Singh, which is yet to be established during the course of trial.

So, without commenting on the merits of the case and keeping in view that the petitioner was having a valid license, the petition stands allowed. The petitioner Jahid Ali is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail bonds to the satisfaction of trial court.
