Petitioners, by way of instant petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C., seek quashing of FIR No.73 dated 16.4.2003 registered under Sections 457, 458, 380 and 120-B IPC at Police Station, Sadar Malout, District Muktsar Sahib, Punjab and the consequential proceedings arising therefrom, on the basis of compromise (Annexure P-2).

Notice of motion was issued and parties were directed to appear before the learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Sri Muktsar Sahib, on 21.4.2015 for getting their statements recorded to enable the learned trial Court to record its satisfaction on the genuineness of the compromise vide order dated 31.3.2015, while adjourning the case for today. However, learned counsel for the petitioners submits that since the petitioners were 11 in number, it was not convenient for them to approach the learned Chief Judicial Magistrate for getting their statements recorded.

In view of the above, present petition is disposed of with liberty to the petitioners to file fresh petition, on the same cause of action, as and when necessity arises.
