The instant petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing of FIR No. 518, dated 30.12.2013, under Sections 406, 498-A IPC, registered at Police Station S.G.M. Nagar, Faridabad, on the basis of compromise.

On 15.12.2014, while issuing notice of motion, this Court had directed the parties to appear before the trial Court for recording of their statements and a report with regard to veracity of the compromise had been called for.

Placed on record is a report dated 28.01.2015 of the Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Faridabad and a perusal of the same would reveal that the statement of the complainant was duly recorded and even though accused, namely, Jatin Sahney had not come present, yet his counsel Mr. G.K. Budhiraja had stated that the compromise has been arrived at between the parties.

Learned counsel appearing for the complainant/

respondent No. 2 i.e. wife of the accused/petitioner makes a statement that the matter has been compromised and she has no objection to the quashing of the FIR.

In the light of the facts of the present case, wherein, a matrimonial dispute between the parties has been amicably resolved, this Court is of the view that it would be a fit case to intervene in exercise of its powers under Section 482 Cr.P.C. to bring to an end the criminal prosecution initiated in the light of the impugned FIR.

Accordingly, the present petition is allowed. Impugned FIR No. 518, dated 30.12.2013, under Sections 406, 498-A IPC, registered at Police Station S.G.M. Nagar, Faridabad and all proceedings emanating therefrom stand quashed.

Petition allowed.
