PW-4 father of the deceased who is an eye-witness has stated the names of four co-accused who had assaulted the deceased. So far as petitioner is concerned, he has not been attributed any role by the said eye-witness but counsel for the State has submitted that the petitioner had caught hold of the deceased, facilitating the crime. The petitioner has not been attributed any injury. It is the co-accused of the petitioner, who had fired at Sunil @ Silli, son of Dilbag Singh.

Taking into consideration the fact that the petitioner has been in custody since 30.01.2014 and having not been attributed any role by the eye-witness, he can be granted the concession of bail.

Without expression of any opinion of merits, the petition is allowed. Petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.
