Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 seeking regular bail in FIR No.30 dated 09.02.2015, under Sections 392,427 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 ('IPC' for short) (Sections 397, 120-B IPC added later on and Section 392 IPC deleted), registered at Police Station Shimlapuri, District Ludhiana.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that co-accused of the petitioner who were similarly situated have been granted bail by this Court. Petitioner is in custody since 24.04.2015.

Learned State counsel who is assisted by Assistant Sub Inspector Ram Singh has opposed the petition, but has failed to controvert the factual aspect of the submissions made by learned counsel for the petitioner.

Accordingly, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this petition is allowed. Petitioner be admitted to bail subject to the satisfaction of Chief Judicial Magistrate, Ludhiana.
