Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for quashing of cross-version of case FIR No.76 dated 3.11.2006 under Sections 336/323/325/148/149 IPC and Sections 30/54/59 of the Arms Act registered at Police Station Badhaur, District Barnala (Annexure P-1) and subsequent proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise dated 12.3.2007 (Annexure P3).

In view of order passed today in CRM-M No.42838 of 2014, the cross-version of FIR No.76 dated 3.11.2006 under Sections 336/323/325/148/149 IPC and Sections 30/54/59 of the Arms Act registered at Police Station Badhaur, District Barnala (Annexure P-1) and

subsequent proceedings arising therefrom are quashed, on the basis of

compromise dated 12.3.2007 (Annexure P3) subject to payment of costs of Rs.7,500/-, to be desposited with the Punjab State Legal Services Authority, Chandigarh.
