Petitioner has been in custody w.e.f. 11.4.2015 on the basis of secret information implicating large number of persons with general allegations.

State counsel informs that intoxicating powder recovered from the petitioner weighing 500 gms. has been found to contain dextropropoxyphene. Co-accused of the petitioner have been granted the concession of bail. The powder containing dextropropoxyphene will not fall under the commercial quantity as it is not more than 500 gms. as per the provisions of law.

Taking into consideration the period of detention suffered by the petitioner, I am of the opinion that the petitioner can be granted the concession of bail as challan has already been presented.

The petition is allowed. It is ordered that the petitioner will be released on bail on his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court subject to the condition that he will not commit the similar offence of which he is accused of during the entire period of trial.
