JASWANT SINGH, J. (ORAL)

Prayer is for grant of regular bail on behalf of two petitioners, who have been arrayed as accused in case FIR No. 167, dated 26.06.2015, for the offence punishable under Section 306 of the Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station Chandimandir, District Panchkula.

The deceased-Rajinder Singh before his death lodged the complaint stating that he has consumed poison substance to commit suicide, which ultimately resulted into his death, due to financial constraints and pressure to turn hostile during the trial of another case.

The wife of complainant has subsequently pointed out the needle of the suspicion on the present accused and their father.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that nobody is named in the statement by the deceased made during his lifetime and even the wife had affixed his signatures on the said statement.

The petitioners are stated to be in custody since
03.10.2015.

Learned State Counsel, assisted by ASI Ilam Singh concedes that the petitioner is custody since 03.10.2015 and after completion of the investigation, challan has been presented.

Without commenting on the merits of the case, keeping in view the facts noticed above; no useful purpose would be served by detaining the petitioners/accused in custody since the trial is not likely to be concluded in near future, the present petition is allowed and the petitioners are ordered to be released on bail subject to satisfaction of CJM/Duty Magistrate concerned.

Disposed of.
