By filing the present petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, the petitioner has sought anticipatory bail, in case FIR No.137, dated 05.11.2014, registered under Sections 323, 324, 326, 148 and 149 IPC, at Police Station Sadar Rup Nagar, District Rup Nagar.

It is contended that the petitioner has been falsely implicated in the present FIR. No specific injury has been attributed to her and there is a delay in lodging the FIR. In pursuance of the order dated 16.12.2014, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

The learned State counsel, on instructions, submits that

in pursuance of the order passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation and she is not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the interim bail granted by this Court vide order dated 16.12.2014, is made absolute, subject to the conditions contained in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

The petition stands allowed.
