The present petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail to petitioner, namely, Arvinder Singh in case FIR No.171 dated 10.10.2015 registered under Sections 21/25/29/61/85 of NDPS Act and Sections 25/27/54/59 of the Arms Act at Police Station Sadar, District Amritsar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has falsely been implicated in the case whereas name of the petitioner was not mentioned in the FIR and he has been implicated on the basis

of statement made by co-accused, namely, Ranjit Singh @ Rana from whom the substance has been recovered. Learned counsel also submits that no recovery was effected from the petitioner and he is in custody since 10.10.2015. Learned counsel further submits that co-accused, namely, Dilbag Singh has already been granted regular bail in **Criminal Misc. No.M-39685 of 2014** on 30.11.2015.

Learned State counsel has not disputed the custody period and also the fact that co-accused, namely, Dilbag Singh has already been granted regular bail.

In view of the submissions made by learned counsel for the petitioner and also the fact that name of the petitioner has not been mentioned in the FIR and no recovery has been effected from him; co-accused, namely, Dilbag Singh has already been granted regular bail in **Criminal Misc. No.M-39685 of 2014** on 30.11.2015, the present petition is allowed and petitioner, namely, Arvinder Singh is directed to be released on regular bail on his furnishing bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, Amritsar.
