MAHESH GROVER, J.

The petitioners pray for their release on bail in terms of Section 438 Cr.P.C. in a case registered vide FIR No.170 dated 14.7.2014 under Sections 323, 307, 452, 506, 34 IPC at Police Station Beri District Jhajjar.

It was contended by the learned counsel for the petitioners that the dispute is between two brothers and their sons and Section 307 IPC was added subsequently. Besides, during the pendency of proceedings the matter is stated to have been settled between the parties.

Noticing the aforesaid, this Court on 22.12.2014 had

granted the interim protection to the petitioners, pursuant to which they joined the investigation to the satisfaction of the Investigating Officer which fact is not disputed by the learned counsel for the State of Haryana.

Having regard to the aforesaid, the interim directions dated 22.12.2014 are hereby made absolute subject to the condition that the petitioners continue to comply with the provisions of Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition allowed.
