Petitioners have filed this petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.168 dated 30.04.2012, under Sections 307 and 304 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 and Section 25 of the Arms Act, 1959, registered at Police Station Assandh, District Karnal.

Learned counsel for the petitioners has submitted that he may be permitted to withdraw the petition qua petitioner No.1.

Ordered accordingly.

Following order was passed by this Court on 30.04.2015:-

“ The present petition has been filed by petitioners Sanjay and Vikas for grant of the anticipatory bail. They have been summoned as an additional accused under Section 319 Cr.P.C by the learned trial Court.

Reply by way of affidavit of Mr. Baljinder Singh, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Assandh, Karnal on behalf of respondent-State filed, which is taken on record.

A date is requested for arguments.

Adjourned to 30.07.2015.

In the meanwhile, the petitioners shall appear before the learned trial Court and in that case they shall be admitted to interim bail. ”

Petitioner No.2 was summoned to face the trial as an additional accused under Section 319 of Criminal Procedure Code, 1973.

Learned counsel for the petitioners has submitted that in pursuance to the orders passed by this Court dated 30.04.2015, petitioner No.2 Vikas has surrendered before the trial Court and has furnished the interim bail.

Accordingly, interim bail furnished by the petitioner No.2 in pursuance to the order dated 30.04.2015, is made absolute.

Petition stands disposed of accordingly.
