Instant petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.170 dated 10.09.2014, registered at Police Station City Roopnagar, District Roopnagar, under Sections 419, 420, 465, 467, 468, 471 and 120-B of the Indian Penal Code.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner appeared before the investigating officer, but his presence was not marked.

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On 14.05.2015 also, learned counsel for the petitioner stated that the investigating officer was not permitting him to join investigation and was not marking his presence. Therefore, in order to enable the petitioner to join the investigation, he was given liberty to appear before the Chief Judicial Magistrate, Rupnagar and move appropriate application for a direction to the investigating officer to allow him to join investigation. The petitioner has not complied with the order dated 14.05.2015. It appears that the petitioner is not interested in joining the investigation. Otherwise also, there are serious allegations of fraud and forgery against the petitioner.

In view of above, no ground for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner is made out.

Dismissed.

It goes without saying that interim order dated 16.12.2014 passed by a Coordinate Bench of this Court stands vacated.
