The petitioner has approached this Court under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, seeking direction to respondent No.2 and 3 to protect her life and liberty which is threatened at the hands of respondent No.4.

There is no assistance on behalf of the petitioner, however, a perusal of the case file reveals that the petitioner has already moved representations (Annexures P-3 and P-4), before respondent No.2, which have not been considered so far.

Having regard to the nature of the order being passed, there appears to be no necessity to call upon the respondents to file their replies/counter affidavits, at this stage.
