Petitioner seeks bail pending trial in FIR No.45 dated 26.02.2014 under Section 384 IPC and Section 376 IPC (added later on), registered at Police Station Tanda, District Hoshiarpur.

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from HC Amrik Singh, Police Station Tanda, Hoshiarpur, submits that prosecution evidence is already over and the next date before the learned trial Court is 11.01.2016.

Faced with the above, learned counsel for the petitioner fairly states that he does not intend to press this petition, at this stage and the same may be dismissed as not pressed, however with a direction to the learned trial Court to conclude the trial at an early date.
