Petitioner seeks quashing of FIR on the basis of compromise which was registered at the instance of Maninder Kumar who as a General Power of Attorney for Santra Devi and Reena who had purchased the property from the petitioner which was registered in the name of his Bua but the property was sold by maternal Aunt (Massi) of petitioner No.1. A registered document has been executed and it is surprising that neither the seller i.e., Bua of petitioner No.1 is a party in the compromise nor the purchasers i.e., Santro Devi and Reena are made party. Permitting compromise in such a situation will be an abuse of process of the Court.

It is also pointed out that the fate of the document and title of the property which has been transferred by registered document is also not disclosed in the present petition.

The petition is dismissed. The Registry is directed to make a note that in case second petition arising out of the same FIR is filed, the same should be indicated by the Registry while putting the petition for hearing.
