Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for quashing of FIR No.64 dated 27.1.2010 under Sections 406, 419, 420, 465, 466, 120-B and 409 IPC registered at Police Station, Karnal Civil Lines, District Karnal.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that at this stage, the petitioner would be satisfied if a direction is issued to the trial Court to expedite the trial as the FIR in question was registered on 27.1.2010. He further submits that the petitioner is a Government employee.

Heard.

The prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioner seems to be justified. Accordingly, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the trial Court to expedite the proceedings.
