Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 seeking regular bail in FIR No.218 dated 25.09.2015, under Sections 409, 34 of Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station Jagraon, District Ludhiana (Rural).

Heard.

As per the prosecution case, on the basis of secret information, petitioner was found in possession of Kerosene oil. Kerosene oil was liable to be sold to the card-holders. It was further the case of the prosecution that in fact, Surinder Singh was the depot-holder, whereas, the kerosene oil in question was recovered from the house of the petitioner, although, he was not the depot-holder. Petitioner is in custody since 25.09.2015.

Keeping in view the fact that the petitioner is in custody since 25.09.2015 and recovery has already been effected, it would be just and expedient to order the release of the petitioner on bail.

Accordingly, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this petition is allowed. Petitioner be admitted to bail subject to the satisfaction of Chief Judicial Magistrate, Ludhiana.
