Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 482 of the Cr.P.C. is for issuance of a direction to respondents No.2 and 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners from respondents No. 6 to 12.

The petitioners have got married against the wishes of their parents. They are stated to be major. Petitioner No.1 in support of her age proof, has placed on record photocopy of her Matriculation Examination Certificate with detailed marks(Annexure P-1) which depicts her date of birth as 10.12.1992. Petitioner No.2 in support of his age proof has also placed on record photocopy of his Identity Card (Annexure P-2) which shows his date of birth as 26.04.1993. They have already moved a representation jointly addressed to Senior Superintendent of Police, District Hoshiarpur and to Senior Superintendent of Police, District Ferozepur for protecting their life and liberty. Copy of the representation is annexed as Annexure P-6.

Without advertng to the merits of the controversy, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the Senior Superintendent of Police, District Hoshiarpur-respondent No.2 to take an appropriate action on the said representation.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending Criminal Misc. Application, if any, also stands disposed of.
