Quashing of FIR No.252 dated 18.07.2013 under Sections 498-A/323
IPC, registered at P.S. Mahesh Nagar is being sought on the basis of compromise
dated 10.10.2014 (Annexure P-2).

Respondent No. 2 got married to petitioner No.1 on 18.02.2011. The
relationship between them became strain and thereafter, the F.I.R was registered
against the petitioners on account of bringing less dowry and harassment caused by
the petitioner and his family members.

However, the matter has now been duly compromised, vide
compromise deed dated 10.10.2014 (Annexure P-2).

On notice a reply has also been filed by respondent No. 1 stating
therein that during the course of the investigation, FIR in question was registered.

In compliance of order dated 16.12.2014, report of Judl Magistrate Ist
Class, Ambala has been received in this regard. As per report, statements of
complainant and both the petitioners have been recorded to the effect that the

compromise is recorded by their free will without any pressure or any undue influence from any corner. The complainant does not want to proceed further against the accused and has no objection, if the present F.I.R be quashed against the petitioner.

Consequently, in view of the status report and in view of the judgment of the Hon'ble Supreme Court in the case of ***Dr. Arvind Barsaul etc. versus State of Madhya Pradesh and another 2008(2) RCR (Criminal) 910***, no useful purpose would be served in prolonging the litigation.

Accordingly, FIR No.252 dated 18.07.2013 under Sections 498-A/323 IPC, registered at P.S. Mahesh Nagar, is quashed along with all consequential proceedings arising therefrom qua the petitioners.

The petition stands disposed of.
