Neither anybody has come present to press this petition nor any request for pass over has been made on behalf of the petitioner. None appeared on the last date of hearing as well. In fact, it is the 23rd date in a row.

After notice having been issued in the application for condonation of delay as far back as on 1.3.2012, nobody has shown any inclination to argue the matter. The instant petition is pending consideration for the last more than about 5 years. Further on 26.2.2015, it was recorded by this Court that petitioner had been granted parole for a period of 4 weeks. It was further observed that since necessary relief has been granted to the petitioner, no further orders were required to be passed.

In view of the above, the present petition does not survive any further and the same is disposed of, as having been rendered infructuous.
