Petitioner has filed this petition under 438 of Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.140 dated 15.10.2014, under Sections 272, 273, 420, 120-B of Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station Amargarh, District Sangrur.

Heard.

As per the prosecution case, 40 litres of spurious milk was recovered from the petitioner.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned State counsel.

In the present case, as per the report of the Food Analyst, sample was found to be adulterated and it was reported that it was substandard and unsafe for human consumption. Offence under Section 420 IPC was also added at a later stage. Allegations levelled against the petitioner are serious in nature.

In these circumstances, no ground for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner, is made out.
