The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No. 186 dated 11.12.2013 registered at Police Station Sadar Kotkapura, District Faridkot, Punjab under Sections 22, 61, 85 of NDPS Act.

Heard.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that after examination of prosecution witness he has filed an application under Section 319 Cr.P.C. and the case is now fixed for summoning of the additional accused. He further states that petitioner is in custody since 11.12.2013 and the trial would take time to conclude.

Learned State counsel submits that service has not been effected upon additional accused.

Without commenting on the merits of the case and considering the fact that there is no other case pending against the petitioner and trial will take long time to conclude, the petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing adequate bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.
