Criminal Misc. No. M-42944 of 2015

Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for issuance of directions to respondents No.2 and 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners at the hands of respondent No.4 to 6.

At this stage, Mr. Paramjit Singh Jammu, Advocate has put in appearance on behalf of respondents No. 4 to 6 and filed Power of Attorney, which is taken on record. He, on instructions from respondent No. 4-Tashvir Pal Kaur wife of Jaspal Singh, who is mother of petitioner No.1), states that there is no threat to the petitioners from private respondents No. 4 to 6.

In view of the statment made by learned counsel appearing for private respondents No. 4 to 6 to the effect that there is no threat to the petitioners from private respondents No. 4 to 6, no further order is required to be issued in the present case.

Accordingly, the present petition is disposed of, however, in case the petitioners feels that there is any threat to their life and liberty, they shall be at liberty to approach concerned SHO, who shall take necessary steps for redressal of their grievance in accordance with law.
