MAHESH GROVER, J.

This is a petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. praying for bail in terms thereof in case FIR No.15 dated 10.11.2014 under Sections 406, 498-A IPC registered at Police Station Women Cell, District Amritsar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner had contended that the petitioner is mother-in-law and has been falsely implicated in this case by the complainant in order to wreak vengeance and otherwise also very vague and general allegations of cruelty in connection with and on account of demand of dowry are assigned to her.

Noticing the aforesaid, interim protection was granted to the petitioner on 18.12.2014, pursuant to which she has joined the investigation which fact is not controverted by the learned counsel for the State.

Having regard to the aforesaid, the interim directions dated 18.12.2014 are hereby made absolute subject to the condition that the petitioner continues to comply with the provisions of Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
