ANITA CHAUDHRY, J(ORAL)

Through the instant petition, the petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in cross case FIR No.117 dated 29.11.2014, registered under Sections 420, 406, 408 IPC, Police Station Bhikhi, District Mansa.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that pursuant to order dated 17.12.2014, passed by the Co-ordinate Bench of this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation twice and has handed over the record.

Learned counsel for the complainant disputes this fact. He states that there is a bank account in which petitioner has deposited the amount in question and is withdrawing the same.

Learned States counsel states that no such bank account has been given.

Looking to all these circumstances, but without commenting on the merits of the case, the petition is allowed and order dated 17.12.2014 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438 Sub Section 2 Clauses (i)(ii) and (iii) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
