Quashing of the FIR No.246 dated 05.11.2012 under Sections 341/294/506/436/379/447/511/120B/148/149 IPC, registered at Police Station Sadar Jagraon, District Ludhiana (Annexure P-1) and its consequential proceedings on the basis of compromise dated 09.02.2014 (Annexure P-2), is being sought.

The FIR was registered on a statement made by Tarsem Singh-respondent No.2/complainant, who is a resident of Village Kakar Tihara, P.S. Sadar Jagraon, District Ludhiana, with the allegations that his land is adjacent to village Baghian and River Satluj and is given to his Taya Malkit Singh-petitioner No.1 on contract for sowing the paddy crop. A dispute arose between Taya Malkit Singh and the complainant with regarding to sowing of the next crop and the complainant started ploughing his field with his own truck. Then Angrej Singh son of Malkit Singh along with Rajwinder Singh son of Malkit Singh armed with stick, came and inflicted injury on the

complainant. In this background the FIR was registered.

The matter has now been compromised between the parties during the trial.

In compliance of the order dated 17.12.2014, status report has been received from the District & Sessions Judge, Ludhiana and the statements of the parties have been recorded to the effect that they have compromised the matter and the complainant has no objection if the present FIR is quashed.

Consequently, in view of the status report and in view of the judgment of the Hon'ble Supreme Court in the case of **Madan Mohan Abbot vs. State of Punjab 2008(2) RCR (Criminal) 429**, the law laid down by the Full Bench of this Court in the case of **Kulwinder Singh and Ors. vs. State of Punjab and another 2007(3) RCR (Crl.) 1052**, no useful purpose would be served in prolonging the litigation.

Accordingly, FIR No.246 dated 05.11.2012 under Sections 341/294/506/436/379/447/511/120B/148/149 IPC, registered at Police Station Sadar Jagraon, District Ludhiana (Annexure P-1), is quashed with all consequential proceedings arising therefrom qua petitioners.

The petition stands disposed of qua petitioners.
