Instant petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No. 814 dated 13.08.2014, registered at Police Station City Sirsa, under Sections 363, 365, 341, 342, 354-A, 201, 120-B read with Section 34 of the Indian Penal Code, Section 10 of the POCSO Act and Section 3 of the SC/ST Act.

Heard learned counsel for the parties.

Vide order dated 06.01.2015, this Court directed that in the event of arrest, the petitioner would be released on interim bail to the

satisfaction of the Arresting/Investigating Officer in connection with above-said case FIR.

On instructions from ASI Jaga Singh, learned State counsel informs that the petitioner has joined the investigation. Learned State counsel further states that nothing is to be recovered from the petitioner and his custodial interrogation is not required.

Having considered the facts and circumstances of the case, order dated 06.01.2015 passed by a Coordinate Bench of this Court is made absolute. However, petitioner is directed to join further investigation, if required.

Present petition is disposed of accordingly.
